Messy Play
How to make **BUBBLE FOAM**
with 3 simple ingredients

INGREDIENTS:
Tear free bubble bath
Water
Food colouring
Hand mixer
Mix 2 parts water to 1 part bubble bath.
For colour, add a little food colouring then whip it with a hand mixer on med-high for one minute.
You want to mix it to the consistency of whipped cream - let your child enjoy the sensory experience. Remember to supervise messy play!

Vitamin D advice for children



It is recommended that children aged one to four years should have a daily 10mcg vitamin D supplement all year round.
As a precaution, all babies under one year should have a daily 8.5-10mcg vitamin D supplement to make sure they get enough.
However, babies who have more than 500ml (about a pint) of infant formula a day don't need a vitamin D supplement as formula is already fortified.
The government recommends that babies are exclusively breastfed until around six months of age.
