

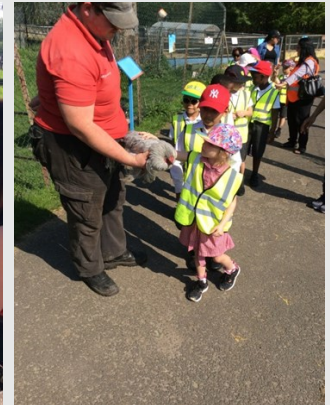
Year 1

This was a guided tour and the staff at the farm were very knowledgeable. The children had the opportunity to see a number of farm animals including alpaca's from Peru, sheep, cows, horses and goats. They learnt the different names for male, female and baby animals, what they are fed at the farm and interesting facts about them. The children also learnt about rabbits and ferrets followed by an opportunity to stroke them.
