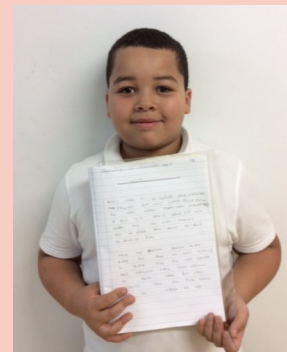


Espresso Star
