





Quick Play Dough Recipe



Some parents have been asking for a simple play dough recipe. The one below is quick to make and is sure to bring hours of creative fun for your child.

Ingredients

- 2 cups of plain flour
- 1 cup of salt
- 1 teaspoon of cream of tartar
- 1 tablespoon of oil
- Optional—food colouring / flavouring

Method

- 1) In a large bowl mix all the ingredients, except the water.
- 2) Add the boiling water and mix with a wooden spoon until cool.
- 3) Once cool knead for 2 / 3 minutes with a little flour. Let your child enjoy playing with the play dough. * always keep your child away from boiling water.
