We value your support in working with us and hope that you will find this information useful.

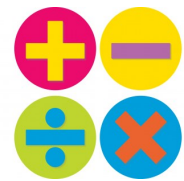
ENGLISH



- In English, we will be reading stories about dinosaurs.
- We will be writing for different purposes e.g. letters and stories
- We will be learning about how to use our sounds to write simple words.
- Every day your child will learn a new sound in RWI.
- We will continue to learn to read through Read Write Inc.



MATHEMATICS



- We will be learning to describe , identify and classify 2D and 3D shapes.
- We will be learning to using language related to position.
- We will be continuing to learn numbers to 20.
- We will be trying to use mathematical language to solve problems.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

- We will be learning about all the different types of dinosaurs.
- We will be talking about what the dinosaurs ate and where they lived.
- We will be looking at animal habitats.
- We will learn about different religions.
- In Computing, we will be improving our basic IT skills .
- We will continue to learn Mandarin.





PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- We will be learning and discussing a variety of strategies to deal with conflict.
- We will be exploring how to maintain positive and respectful relationships with others.
- We will be learning about respecting others beliefs.
