At Winsor Primary School staff and Governors are concerned that all aspects of school life are 'fair' and 'safe' for pupils, staff, parents, carers and all our visitors.

We are committed to multi agency working in order to meet the Every Child Matters agenda and ensure that every child is able to fulfil their potential by overcoming barriers to learning.

The School:

Will provide a high quality education, with great teaching and wonderful learning experiences.
Will build a safe and secure school community based on kindness and generosity where bullying of any kind is not tolerated and all pupils feel valued.
Will treat pupils with respect at all times, be clear in our expectations with regards to academic achievement and behaviour and be consistent in applying them.
Will mark pupils' work quickly and give feedback that helps them make progress.
Will act professionally at all times in dealing with pupils and their families.
Will always support pupils through difficult times, work with individuals and their family to overcome problems
Will provide skilled teaching to ensure children enjoy reading, write fluently and speak confidently.
Will ensure that parents receive regular updates on their child's progress, have regular opportunities to discuss progress with teachers, and be responsive at all times to pupils' aspirations and concerns.
Will keep parents informed about school activities and follow agreed School Policies and Code of Conduct.

I/We shall try to:

Ensure that children attend school regularly and are punctual.
Ensure that children are prepared and bring appropriate equipment to school, e.g. reading book bags and PE kit.
Provide support for discipline within the school - encouraging and modelling polite behaviour.
Be realistic about children's abilities offering encouragement and praise.
Ensure early contact is made with school to discuss matters which may affect a child's happiness, progress or behaviour.
Participate in discussions concerning children's progress, attainment and behaviour.
Communicate promptly with the school, returning forms, letters, etc.
Support children with reading and other school related activities.
Give due importance to assignments for completion at home.
Allow children to take increasing responsibility as they progress throughout the school.
Participate in the development of school policy.

Maintain a positive attitude towards decisions made by the school.
Encourage children to be presentable and correctly dressed in school uniform.
Provide an enabling home environment.
Ensure that children behave respectfully in school uniform, even outside of school.
Communicate issues or concerns with staff politely and respectfully.

The Pupil will:

Uphold school rules.
Attend school regularly and be on time.
Care for the school's environment and the equipment in it.
Be organized and prepared - bringing the necessary equipment or kit for lessons as requested by staff, taking letters home promptly, returning reading books regularly
Be polite - conducting themselves in an orderly manner both inside and outside school, in line with the school's values especially when wearing school uniform.
Being presentable and wearing the correct school uniform at all times
Maintaining a positive attitude towards all aspects of school life, showing grit in times of difficulty
Take a growing responsibility for their own learning
Try their best at everything and take a pride in their work
